Warren "Bill" Young, 88, of Napoleon formerly of McClure, Ohio died Monday, January 20, 2014 at Spring Meadows Care Center, Holland, Ohio. He was born November 24, 1925 in Warren, Indiana to the late Hardin and Lila (Lewis) Young. On January 1, 1949, he married Charlene (Inskeep) Young in Fort Wayne, Indiana who were united in marriage for 61 years until her death on May 21, 2010.

He will be remembered as a devoted husband and hardworking family man that enjoyed time with his children and grandchildren.
