



Weldon K. Frysinger

May 17, 1921 - August 14, 2018

Weldon K. Frysinger, 97, of Napoleon, Ohio died Tuesday, August 14th, 2018 at the Napoleon Genacross Lutheran Home. He was born May 17, 1921 in Liberty Township, Ohio to the late Glenn and Vera (Kitter) Frysinger. In 1946 he married Roberta (Freeworth) Frysinger and she preceded him in death on Apr. 14, 1973. On Aug. 3, 1974, he married Helen (Hoover) Fisher Frysinger. Weldon was a 1939 graduate of Liberty Center High school. He served in the United States Army Air Corp. as a Sergeant from 1942-1945. After the war, Weldon started working for his uncle, Leil Dunbar at The L.S. Dunbar Co. (Lincoln-Mercury/International Harvester Dealership) until Leil's death in 1968. Then Weldon along with his brother, Burdette purchased the business and continued to operate it until they retired in 1987.

Weldon was an active member of St. Paul United Methodist Church, Napoleon. He was also a member of the Napoleon Masonic Lodge, Napoleon American Legion, and enjoyed playing golf after he retired.

He is survived by his wife, Helen; children, Ken (Peg) Frysinger of Napoleon, Ohio, Judy (Mike) Russell of Delaware, Ohio, Linda (Brad) Gerken of Napoleon, Ohio, and William (Leslie) Frysinger of Ayersville, Ohio; stepson, Joel (Karen) Fisher of Rockledge, Florida; grandchildren, Jamie (Mark) Kerr, Nick Frysinger, Amanda (DJ) Butler, Katrina (Nick) Kaupp, Jackie Russell, Brian (Jenny) Gerken, Ross (Stacy) Gerken, Emily (Troy) Hoste, and Kelsey Frysinger; 12 great grandchildren; and sisters, Wylodene Baughman and Jeanette Harms, both of Napoleon. He was also preceded in death by

brothers, Doyle, Burdette, and Delmar Frysinger, and a sister, Dorothy Dunbar.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Friday, August 17 at St. Paul United Methodist Church, Napoleon with visitation from 9:30 - 11 a.m.

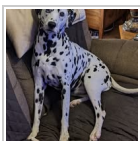
