Thomas P. Williams Jr., died peacefully on Thursday, December 2, 2010 at home with family around him. He was born in Toledo, OH on February 18, 1929 to Thomas Page and Mae Williams, Sr. He graduated from Holgate High School in 1947. After serving in the army during the Korean War, he settled in Napoleon, OH; where he began his sales career. He sold travel trailers and manufactured homes and established Williams Mobile Home Park on Scott Street.
