Robert Wayne Woods, 76, of Deshler, Ohio died Wednesday morning, May 14, 2008 at the Wood County Hospital, Bowling Green, Ohio. He was born January 21, 1932 in Findlay, Ohio to the late Harley R. and Myrtle (Stienman) Woods. On June 6, 1951 he married Marguerite (Blunk) Woods in Rawson, Ohio and she preceded him in death on March 17, 1999. On January 10, 2000 he married Barbara L. Seedorf and she also preceded him in death on March 22, 2002. Bob was a 1949 graduate of Findlay High School and served with the U.S. Army as a Corporal during the Korean War. He was a truck driver for over 18 years with the Findlay, Ohio Division of Signal Delivery, St. Joe, Michigan; retiring in 1995. He previously drove truck for Eazor Motor Freight, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and the former Koppenhofer Poultry, Deshler. He was a member of Peace Lutheran Church, Deshler and the Deshler American Legion Post #316. Bob was a devoted Toledo Mud Hens and Detroit Tigers Fan. He enjoyed countless games with the Mud Hens as a season ticket holder from 1999-2007.
