Charles G. Young, 91, of Napoleon, Ohio, formerly of New Bavaria, Ohio, died Tuesday, November 22, 2011 at the Napoleon Lutheran Home. Born June 30, 1920 in Pleasant Township, he was the son of Orville L. & Nora M. (Wolf) Young. On October 30, 1943, he married Martha (Ricker) Young, who survives. Charles was a lifelong resident of Henry County and a farmer retiring in 1983. He was an active member of St. John Lutheran Church, Holgate, serving as Sunday School treasurer, church president, vice president, and elder. He served as township trustee in Pleasant Township for 20 years, and was Ohio township association director and officer for 9 years. He served on the board of directors of Farmers Elevator Grain and Supply of Pleasant Bend and North Creek for 20 years, 9 years as its president, board of directors of New Bavaria Telephone Company for many years, member of Pleasant Valley Farm Bureau council, member of the Henry County Farm Bureau, where he was president for 3 years, and past member and president of Henry County Regional Planning Commission. He was a veteran of World War II and member of the Holgate American Legion, The New Bavaria VFW, The Holgate Lions Club, and a member of the Henry County & Ohio Townships Association and the Henry County Public Employees Retirees, Inc. He is also survived by a daughter, Cheryl (Tom) Young-Sebo of Carmichael, CA and son, David (Deb) of Defiance, 2 grandchildren, Alex and Lisa Young. He was preceded in death by his parents, an infant son, and brothers, Merl and Roscoe Young. Funeral services will be held on Monday, Nov. 28 at 11 a.m. at the

Rodenberger Funeral Home in Napoleon. Interment will follow at Forest Hill Cemetery where military honors will be accorded by the Holgate American Legion and New Bavaria VFW.
