Zelma Johnson, 96, of rural McClure, died Monday, April 3, 2017 at Grand Rapids Care Center, Grand Rapids, Ohio. She was born February 15, 1921 in Damascus Township, Ohio to the late Ray and Geneva (Whitehead) Jennings. On September 1, 1940 she married Floyd "Eldon" Johnson, who preceded her in death on October 3, 2007.
