Jesse W. Zimmerman, 93, of Westhope, Ohio, died Thursday at the Lutheran Home in Napoleon, Ohio. He was born May 13, 1915 in Westhope to the late Robert and Harriet (Neifer) Zimmerman. On April 19, 1943, he married Gretchen Reinbolt in Custar, Ohio, who survives in Westhope, Ohio. Jesse was a parts identifier for quality control at Daybrook in Rossford and Erie Ordnances. He was a member of the United States Army from December 1942 to January of 1946 and was the oldest member of the Roberts-McMillen American Legion Post #332 of McClure, where he was a member for over 60 years. He is survived by many loving nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by brothers, Alva, Harry and Robert Zimmerman and a sister, Wilmetta Shidler. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday at 11 am at the Rodenberger Funeral Home in McClure. Interment will follow at the Olive Branch Cemetery in McClure with military rites accorded by the McClure Legion Post #332.
